

2022 - 2023 ODP Cost Breakdown



ODP Program Registration: \$135

What does this cover and include?

1. All administrative duties during the ODP Season.
 2. Eligible to register for each State ODP ID Center.
-

ODP ID Centers: \$40

This must be paid upon registration for the event and covers field usage, staff, travel, administrative items, etc.

*NOTE: This year we are instituting a Late Fee for those who register after an event's registration closes on the Wednesday of the week of the event.

Uniforms: ODP uniforms are also needed so your child is easily identified by staff and so they look professional and can participate in Team based events when invited! The Full Uniform which must be worn at training and games includes:

- Grey Jersey, Red Jersey, & Blue Jerseys - \$25 each (same as last year)
- Blue Shorts (same as last year) - \$18
- Blue Socks (same as last year) - \$12

*Uniforms are purchased separately from other fees. Returning players only need to purchase items they do not have. Additional shorts and socks may be purchased.

What other costs may occur in the ODP Season?

Progressing through the Age Group Pool part of the season may include invitations to several events:

- Sub-Regional Events (\$150 - \$250)
 - South Intraregional Scouting & College Combine (\$150 - \$220)
 - Region ID Camp (\$600 - \$800).
